## British Championships

- Monique McCarroll won a Silver medal in the Women's Platform Event. This was an excellent result and means she qualifies to compete in the Grand Prix Circuit with the Great Britain Team in Germany, Canada and the United States.
- Jenny Leeming finished in a very creditable 10<sup>th</sup> place in the Women's Platform Event
- Niki Bennet came 12<sup>th</sup> in the Men's Platform Event. This was Niki's first British senior competition where he was competing against Britain's top divers

## The difference between Senior, Age Group and Novice Competitions Part 1.

### Novice Competitions

- These are the first events divers will compete in
- They are divided into different age groups – **7&U, 8 / 9 years , 10 / 11 years , 12 / 13 years , 14 – 16 years**
- 7& U perform a spring header and a crouching back dive from poolside, 2 dives from 1 metre one of which must be a forward line-up
- 14 – 16 age group must perform a forward dive and back dive from 1 metre, 2 other dives from 1 metre and a forward or back line-up from 3 metre
- All other age groups perform a forward dive tuck and a back dive from poolside, 2 dives from 1 metre and a forward or back line-up from 3 metre
- The ASA (England) do not have a 7&U group and start at age 9
- The judging in these competitions is much more lenient than in Age Group and Senior events
- Novice competitions have a friendly atmosphere. They are meant to encourage children to participate in the sport.
- There is a big difference in standard between Novice and “Age Group” level.

### Selection for Scottish Squad.

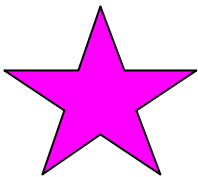

### Change of dates

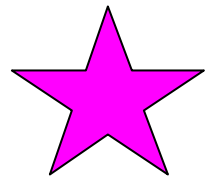
The Dates for the Thistle Trophy have changed to the 6<sup>th</sup> – 7<sup>th</sup> December..... VERY IMPORTANT
